

Africell Group to exit Uganda

7 September 2021 – For commercial reasons, Africell Group is exiting the Ugandan market. All Africell UG mobile network services in Uganda will terminate on 7 October 2021 (the ‘Termination Date’), after which Africell UG will no longer be available as a roaming partner in the country.

Roaming partners owing balance to Africell UG should arrange to pay outstanding dues through Africell UG’s financial clearing house, Syniverse, by the Termination Date. Balance owed by Africell to roaming partners will be paid by that date as well. For accurate invoices to be generated, TAP files should be sent by 7 October 2021.

This statement announces the end of Africell UG’s services in Uganda and serves as formal notice for the termination of related roaming agreements. The ‘Confirmation of Termination of Agreement’ letter (below/attached) will also be completed by roaming partners in due course and following settlement of all accrued balances.
